**AAP ANNOUNCES
THE OUTSTANDING PROFESSIONAL AND SCHOLARLY TITLES OF 2002**

Washington, DC, Wednesday, January 29, 2003 – Continuing an important tradition of honoring exemplary scholarship, the Association of American Publishers' Professional/Scholarly Publishing Division today announced the winner of the R.R. Hawkins Award for the Outstanding Professional Reference or Scholarly Work of 2002. The award will be presented to author David Freedberg and the University of Chicago Press for *The Eye of the Lynx: Galileo, His Friends, and the Beginnings of Modern Natural History* at AAP PSP's 27th Annual Awards Ceremony at the Annual Conference at the Renaissance Mayflower Hotel in Washington, DC. The Hawkins Award, which is named for the former head of the Science and Technology Division of the New York Public Library, is being presented along with 33 additional awards for outstanding books, journals, and electronic products in a host of academic disciplines.

“We congratulate Professor Freedberg, the University of Chicago Press and all of the other recipients,” said Patricia S. Schroeder, President and Chief Executive Officer, AAP. “Our awards panel, which consists of a retired librarian, former bookseller, and retired publishers who are themselves former academics, have identified what they consider to be the very best scholarly works for the past year. Selecting these winners is a painstaking yet ultimately rewarding process, for promoting and encouraging the dissemination of scholarship is one of AAP's primary missions.”

In *The Eye of the Lynx: Galileo, His Friends, and the Beginnings of Modern Natural History*, Freedberg traces the history of a little-known scientific organization from seventeenth-century Italy, the Academy of Linceans (or Lynxes), which aimed at nothing less than the documentation and classification of all nature in pictorial form. The book is the first book-length study of the Linceans to appear in English, and it documents the unprecedented use of drawings based on microscopic observation and other new techniques of visualization, including sectioning,

dissection and observation of internal structures. The book uses carefully selected illustration and engagingly written text to depict this crucial episode in the development of visual

representation and natural history. And perhaps as important, it offers readers a dazzling array of early modern drawings, from magnificently depicted birds and flowers to frogs in amber, monstrously misshapen citrus fruits, and more.
